It's two o'clock on a Saturday afternoon in the centre of Newcastle upon Tyne. The city-centre streets are filled with people. Some are busy shoppers, others are visitors waiting for the revelries to start and there are some who have just "gone up to the toon" for the afternoon. Suddenly a five metre banner is raised proclaiming "Healing" and a group of 20 to 30 Christians fall on their knees in prayer! Quite an unusual event you might think, however, what is more unusual is what happens when these Christians have finished their prayer – they then hand out leaflets to passers-by, inviting them to receive prayer for healing.

Anyone who accepts this offer of prayer for healing is then led to one of the chairs where a team of 3 or 4 will pray with them.



This is Healing on the Streets and this has been taking place in the centre of Newcastle every Saturday afternoon since Oct 3rd 2008.

In that time, there have been many healings, but perhaps the greatest healing of all has been the healing between the different Christian denominations which take part in Healing on the Streets.

When in a praying team, praying with a complete stranger, in the middle of a busy city centre street, differences in tradition seem to become insignificant. Truly a demonstration of "That which unites us is far greater than anything which differentiates us".

The Healing on the Streets ministry was developed in the Causeway Coast Vineyard church in Coleraine, Northern Ireland, from there it has spread to many towns and cities in the UK and Europe.

In Newcastle, there have been three training sessions, each starting on a Friday evening and continuing until the Saturday afternoon healing session on the streets. So far, there are over 300 people from more than 30 different congregations who have been trained in this ministry, so there is no requirement to go out on the street every week.

The Healing on the Streets ministry is principally a pastoral ministry rather than an evangelical one, however, for many who come for healing prayer, it is the first time that they have been told that God loves them and that Jesus died for them, so some have been led to the Lord.

The next training course is scheduled for November 6th /7th 2009.
